• Extracts from Rules & Regulations •

1. That the competition be open unless otherwise stated in the prize list.
2. District classes are confined to the property of any person residing within Alston Moor and the parishes of Kirkhaugh, Knaresdale, Coanwood, Hartley Burn and land west of the West Allen in Whitfield Parish.
3. That all stock shall be bona-fide the property of the exhibitor. All syndicate animals to be entered under all owners' names.
4. All protests must be lodged in writing with the secretary within seven days of the show, together with £1 deposit, which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
5. The committee and stewards have the full power to prohibit any animal entering the ring which has been entered for competition contrary to the rules of the society.

N.B All sheep coming onto the field must have animal movement licences and all cattle must have cattle passports. Animals will not be permitted to show without these as there is a potential fine of
