Ear Tags

Should your sheep lose it's ear tags and to abide by tagging rules you can either replace the tags lost with a like for like tag using the existing number i.e. the one the sheep lost or if your tag manufacturer will not provide this option then replace it using a new tag, this being red, if the sheep was not born on your holding. If a new tag is provided it must include the original ZSA details on it.

Please note if using a new number then you will need to contact the Secretary who will issue a new certificate with the updated number

30th November 2018 is F

You must name all rams that you register while females are not compulsory.

The name of the animal must not exceed 21 characters including your prefix



There are no changes to the registration fees this year therefore the following still applies to all members:-

Lambs must be registered by 5 months of age or late fees apply.

Female Registrations are still £6 or £5 if done online.

Male Registrations are £20.

After five months of age the fees go up by £10 therefore the fees are £16 for a female and £30 for a male.
